The Baraboo Public Library and the **International Crane Foundation (ICF)** are teaming up to offer families a free pass to ICF this summer. **From July 30 through October 31**, use your library card to check out an **Adventure Pass** at the library, good for admission to the International Crane Foundation for two adults and up to four kids, ages 6 through 17. (Kids 5 and under get in free.) You may check out the pass for one week. No holds are possible with the pass, which must be checked out from and returned at the Baraboo Public Library. There will be 10 passes available for checkout. See the library website for details!

library special events, such as the Very Merry Unbirthday Party fundraiser in January 2018.

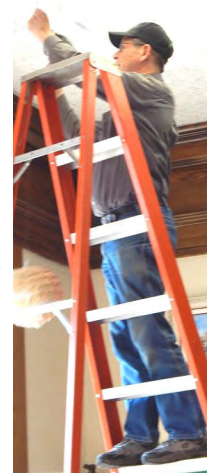
