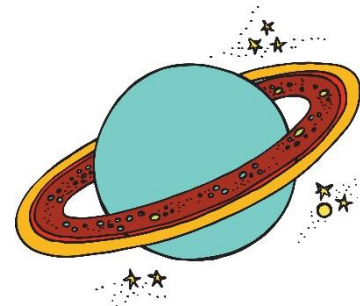


BARABOO PUBLIC LIBRARY TEENS
