PARADE RULES

- * Families, individuals, and businesses may participate.
- * Create your scarecrow on your own OR at the library-sponsored workshop at Ochsner Park on Saturday, September 21 from 10 - Noon.
- * Scarecrows can be displayed at Ochsner Zoo, in your yard, or in front of your business.
- * Register your scarecrow at the library between August 12 and September 21 and receive an official display card.
- * Securely attach your official display card to your creation.
- * Your scarecrow must be on display by September 21st to qualify for the contest.
- * Your scarecrow can be any size.
- * Your scarecrow must be able to stand or sit on its own, tied to a chair, a pole, or a stake.
- * Store-bought masks are not allowed.
- * Content on all scarecrows should be suitable for viewing by all ages.
- * Any scarecrows displayed on zoo property cannot have political or religious statements or business advertising.
- * Scarecrows on Ochsner Zoo property should be removed by October 14.
- * Prizes will be awarded in five categories: Silliest, Most Creative, Best Book Character, Best Business and People's Choice.
- * If you use a library-owned scarecrow frame, we ask that when the "Parade" is over, return the frame to the library so it can be used again in 2020.
