# General Considerations

- Reading Room needs to be flexible to accommodate for programming opportunities
- Program Room needs to be a non-sterile space
- Not enough space in general
- Cameras, security, and safety
- Expanding to the North
- Move restrooms to the front near entrance
- Book Sale room
- Baraboo Area Literacy Council storage space
- Consider all site options and creative solutions (building more levels), including a new location
- Quiet Space (glassed reading room)
- Rent basement out as office space.
- Clear signage and wayfinding tools
